- 1908 - Model T on sale for the first time



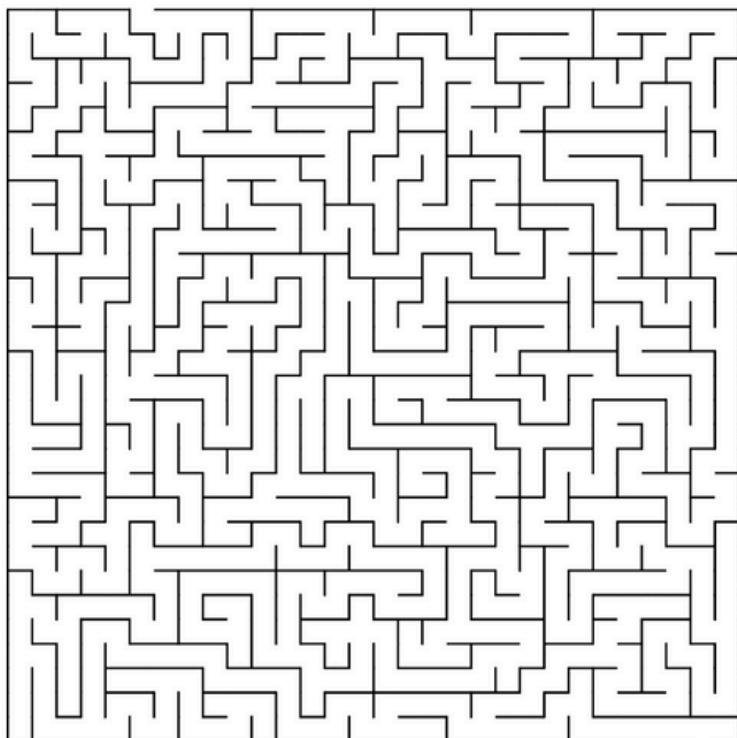

Roger Clayton Schiffner was born right here in Belle Fourche on September 29, 1958. He grew up on the north end of town, one of 5 boys, and graduated from the local high school, Class of '78. It was no surprise to learn the name of his favorite sports team: The Broncos! As for work, he said he hauled garbage for the City of Belle Fourche for years, all before the new trucks which have made the job so much easier. He still does work occasionally as an Uber driver. Roger's is a familiar face at Silver Lining. I would venture to say that almost everyone who works or eats at our senior center readily recognizes him. He's always quick with a comment that will make you laugh, and I really doubt if Roger has ever met a stranger. I asked him how he came to volunteer at Silver Lining, and it turns out a friend invited him to lunch one day a few years back, and the rest is history. What does he enjoy most about the job? "All the people." As a volunteer of several years, he is always willing to pitch in and help wherever he can. In fact, it was apparent to me that, center to his very nature is his willingness to help. He is very proud of his participation in the Belle Fourche branch of CATs, the Western South Dakota Community Action Team which has helped so many local people in need, and whose goal is to "lift people out of the cycle of poverty." He said he had even been president of the local organization at one time. When I Googled it, I saw that Roger still sits on its board of directors in Rapid City. He also helps by hauling people without means or transportation to



medical appointments, etc. when needed. It was clear to me that Roger is a man with a Big Heart. When I asked him if he had a whole day to do whatever he wanted to do, what would it be, he quipped, "That's easy! Nothing." Well, it turns out he likes watching the old Westerns on TV, and we agreed that John Wayne's "True Grit" was a good one. His favorite TV series? "Walker, Texas Ranger." He also likes country music. His favorite song? Randy Travis' "Three Wooden Crosses." His favorite flavor of ice cream? Butter Pecan! His favorite spot on Planet Earth? Belle Fourche, South Dakota! His dream vacation would be to take a train trip to Alaska. One item he wouldn't want to be without: His glasses. Favorite reading matter? The newspaper. Favorite Silver Lining meal? "Too many to pick just one," but top of the list: Chicken Fried Steak, Meatloaf, Goulash. When I asked him if he had any suggestions how to make our newsletter even better, his response was, "Nope, they're doing a good job!"



# Meal Participants of Belle Silver Lining

Please read carefully the explanations below regarding our meals program at Belle Silver Lining:

We are a non-profit organization that relies on state funding and donations in order to provide nutritional meals each day.

Our current estimated costs for producing each meal is minimum \$11-\$13.00 per meal. Suggested donations on your behalf (if you are over 60 years of age) has been \$5.00 per meal. Our state funding pays for \$3.79 per meal. If you do the math that means our Center is going in the hole financially approximately \$2.21-\$4.21 per meal. We can no longer continue to fund this shortage. Our meals program is for Seniors over 60 years of age, however, anyone can eat at the Center BUT those who are not 60 years of age are supposed to pay the full amount for the meal. In the past this has not been enforced.

We cannot continue allowing this to happen.

AS OF AUGUST 15, 2024 THE FOLLOWING WILL BE ENFORCED:

\*MINIMUM SUGGESTED DONATION PER MEAL WILL BE: \$7.00

\*IF YOU TAKE MORE THAN 1 MILK PER MEAL, AN ADDITIONAL DONATION OF \$1.00 IS EXPECTED PER MILK.

\*NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF 60 WITHOUT DISABILITIES, (THIS INCLUDES CAREGIVERS), WILL QUALIFY FOR THE "SUGGESTED DONATION" STATUS THEY WILL BE REQUIRED TO PAY THE FULL AMOUNT OF \$10.00 PER MEAL. (you may be asked to show ID)

\*IF YOU TAKE MORE THAN ONE MEAL, PLEASE PAY ACCORDINGLY.

\*WE ASK THAT EVERYONE TAKE TIME TO LEARN HOW TO CHECK IN AT THE FRONT DESK ON THE KIOSK FOR THE MEALS, WITHOUT YOUR REGISTRATION FOR EACH MEAL WE CANNOT RECEIVE PROPER STATE FUNDING TO COVER OUR COSTS.

## Pumpkin Basics

### Canned Pumpkin

- Canned pumpkin is convenient and available year round.
- Unopened canned pumpkin is safe to eat for up to 5 years after the 'use by' or 'best by' date if the can has no dents, rust or swelling.
- Once opened, canned pumpkin can be kept in the refrigerator for 3 to 4 days.

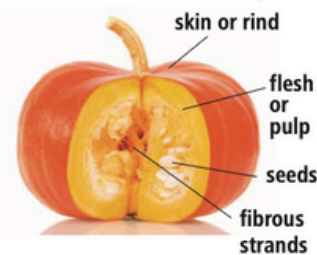

### Shop and Save

- Pumpkins are a type of winter squash available in October and November.
- Pumpkins grown for cooking are called "pie pumpkins" and usually weigh from 2 to 10 pounds. Their flesh makes a smooth and flavorful puree.
- Choose pie pumpkins that are firm and heavy for their size, without cracks or soft spots.
- Each pound of uncut pumpkin will provide 1 to 1½ cups of cooked puree.
- Seeds can be dried and saved for growing pumpkins next year.

### The Parts of a Pumpkin



### Store Well Waste Less



- Store whole pumpkins in a cool, dark and dry place for up to 3 months.
- Scrub pumpkins under running water before cutting or cooking. Once cut, wrap tightly and store in the refrigerator for up to 1 week.
- Freeze cooked or unused canned pumpkin to use later. Package in airtight containers and use within 1 year.
- Roast the seeds from any type of pumpkin.

Pumpkins grown for carving are often large and have a thinner wall of flesh that can be cooked but the texture and flavor are not pleasant.

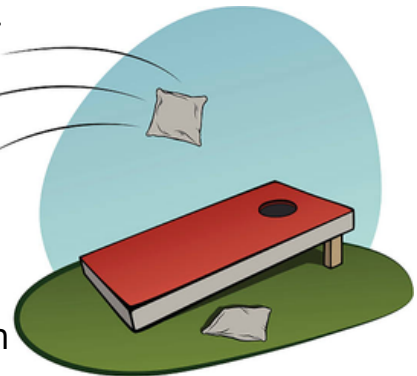
